8. **Plenary session (with all groups together): Citizenship, Rights and Duties, Social Change**





IMPACT AND RESULTS



- **75 PEOPLE HAVE RECEIVED DIRECT TRAINING**
- Debate on respect for diversity, migration processes, analysis of the rise of islamophobia.
- Reject of Muslin people (stigmatized people directly seen as violent. Strong link between Islam and terrorism).
- Ignorance about concepts like Arab, Muslim, Islamist and other linked to foreign people.
- Tackling of prejudices and stereotypes.
- Approach of respect for diversity, people and Human Rights

IMPACT AND RESULTS



- February 2019. PRESENTATION OF FINAL RESULTS during Humans Fest – International Film and Human Rights Festival of Valencia.
- Debate with experts from third sectors as well as Public Institutions working on Human Rights and Migration with a European approach.

- Have Human Rights professionals and people of different faiths taking part or delivering the sessions.
- Use first person approaches in the trainings.
- Direct stakeholders involved in the trainings (Muslim/migrants/refugees)
- Address also second and third generations of migrants people
