IMPACT AND RESULTS



75 PEOPLE HAVE RECEIVED DIRECT TRAINING

- Debate on respect for diversity, migration processes, analysis of the rise of islamophobia.
- Reject of Muslin people (stigmatized people directly seen as violent. Strong link between Islam and terrorism).
- Ignorance about concepts like Arab, Muslim, Islamist and other linked to foreign people.
- Tackling of prejudices and stereotypes.
- Approach of respect for diversity, people and Human Rights
